The smallest state faces the biggest problem.


Tlaxcala is the smallest state in Mexico, however it has a high number of patients with Chronic Renal Failure.

- Tlaxcala has the first place in Mexico in Chronic Renal Failure, and it mainly affects young people between 15 and 24 years old.
- Tlaxcala has an incidence of 119.66 cases per 100,000 inhabitants.
- The town of Huamantla has a very high incidence.
- Treatment is very expensive.

HealthCare background.

Only 77.2% of Mexicans have access to a healthcare system:

- 44% IMSS 33.96% of the total
- 7% ISSSTE 05.40% of the total
- 4% other Public or Private Healthcare 03.09% of the total
- 45% are affiliated to Seguro Popular 34.75% of the total

According to data from the National Survey of Employment and Social Security, INEGI, 2013.



HealthCare background.

The most important healthcare system is Seguro Popular and covers only 34.75% of Mexican population.

Unfortunately, in the Coverage Catalog of Seguro Popular, Chronic Renal Failure is not covered.

Thus, if we add it to 22.80% of the population, we can conclude that:

57.55% of Mexicans won't have access to healthcare in case of Chronic Renal Failure.



High costs.


Renal Diseases require very expensive treatment. The cost of care for a single patient can reach **up to \$ 1,600 a month**. **Roberto Salinas González**, nephrologist.

Tlaxcala is **the third state in Mexico with more Deaths** due to Chronic Renal Failure.

- Constant education to patients and families.




Investment

 - ~\$663,000 MXN.




Project scope.
